SAINTS CORNER - BLESSED KATERI TEKAWITHA Kateri was born in New York in the year 1656, the daughter of a Mohawk warrior. She was four years old when her mother died of smallpox. The disease also attacked Kateri and transfigured her face. As a teenager, she converted to Catholicism and incurred the great hostility of her tribe. She lived a life dedicated to prayer, penitential practices, and cared for the sick and aged. Devotion to the Eucharist and Jesus Crucified were daily occurrences. Her death was on April 17, 1680. She is the patroness of the environment and ecology. Her feast day is July 14th.
