BAPTISMS

SAINTS CORNER: St. Ignatius of Loyola was born in the family castle in Spain, the youngest of 13 children. When he was old enough, he became a page, and then a soldier of Spain to fight the French. A cannon ball and a series of bad operations ended his military career in 1521. While St. Ignatius recovered, he read the lives of the saints, and decided to dedicate himself to becoming a soldier for the Catholic Faith. Soon after he experienced visions, but a year later suffered a trial of fears and scruples, driving him almost to despair. Our of this experience he wrote his famous "Spiritual Exercises". He started his order called The Society of Jesus, or Jesuits. He died at the age of 65 and his feast day is July 31.
