**MAKE A GIFT THROUGH AN IRA CHARITABLE ROLLOVER** If you are over the age of 70 1/2, you must take a required minimum distribution from your IRA. Normally, the amount of the distribution is taxed as ordinary income. However, federal legislation enacted on October 3, 2008 extends the opportunity for you, for the remainder of 2008 and throughout 2009, to make a direct distribution from your IRA to a qualified charity, such as Church of the Holy Spirit, Holy Spirit Catholic School, one of our four Catholic High School, the education of seminarians, and of other various ministries within the diocese. Such distributions, while not subject to income tax, will still count toward fulfilling your required minimum distribution. For more information call 269-3915.
