BAPTISMS

ASH WEDNESDAY MASS SCHEDULE: 8:00am and 6:30pm. Ash Wednesday is a day of fasting and abstinence from meat. The Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence from meat.

LENTE REGULATIONS ON FAST AND ABSTINENCE Adults ages 18 to 59 are bound to fast on the Fridays of Lent. Fasting means one primary meal during the day, and two smaller meals. All persons age 14 or older are obliged to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these acts of penance. Those who are unable to fast can perform an act of charity. All Catholics should be formed in an authentic sense of Penance.

ASH WEDNESDAY OFFERING FOR THE CENTER OF HOPE: Center of Hope provides rent and utility assistance to needy families in the Sedgwick County area. It is an apostolate of the Sisters Adorers of the Blood of Christ. Our own parishioner, Sister Becky Balthazor, A.S.C., works on its staff. A basket will be placed at the entrance to the church this Ash Wednesday before each mass. Could you make a contribution to help needy families. Last year the Center helped 2,030 families, that is 5,219 persons, with assistance of \$65,000-85,000 per month. Our parish Crisis Fund is also making a donation toward this apostolate.
