**CORRECTION ON LENTEN REGULATIONS ON FAST AND ABSTINENCE** Last week we inadvertently switched the rules on fasting and abstinence. All persons age 14 or older are obliged to abstain from meat on the Fridays of Lent. Fridays in Lent are not mandatory days of fasting. Fasting is required on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday and binds those ages 18 to 60.
