REGISTRATIONS

BAPTISMS

Baptisms are celebrated on the second Sunday of each month after the 10:00 Mass. Parents who plan to have their child baptized are required to attend our **Baptismal Preparation Class** held the second Sunday of each month in the school office. You are strongly encouraged to attend this class before your child is born. The Baptism Information Form must be returned to the parish office prior to the scheduled baptism. MARRIAGES

In order for weddings to take place here at the Church of the Holy Spirit, either the bride or groom must be registered in the parish for a minimum of six months before preparations for marriage will begin. Joshua's Hope. Unemployment affects everyone. Chances are we all know someone who has recently lost a job. With unemployment can come an emotional roller coaster, feeling angry, resentful, confused, embarrassed, scared, or isolated. Added to this can be deep loss of self worth, even depression or despair.

St. Paul calls the Church the Body of Christ, and he writes, "If one member suffers, all suffer together with it." (I Cor 12:26). The diocesan Respect Life and Social Justice Office will sponsor *Joshua's Hope: Parish Support for Those Seeking Employment*. This project is about connecting persons to retain a sense of hope and building resources while searching for employment.

Four sessions facilitated by persons with varied backgrounds and expertise, hopefully to be followed by a leader in each of the parish-based support groups.

Session One: Hope and Trust in God

During this time of job searching, the importance of faith, hope, and prayer is emphasized. A short video clip by John Foppe, a personal improvement expert, will generate new inspirations. The updated Catholic Assistance Directory for the Wichita Metro area and other related aid materials are distributed.

Session Two: Day to Day Living

Varied ways to cope with stress are learned, along with practical ideas on how to stretch a budget. *Living Your Strengths*, a book on how to identify and affirm your talents, is distributed. Participants take the Clifton Strengths Finder, a personality assessment tool that reveals top five talent themes.

Session Three: Discovering our Strengths

Results from the Clifton Strengths Finder assessment tool are shared and analyzed. During mock job interviews, participants practice expressing discovered strengths. Skills to update a resume for today's job market are learned.

Session Four: Going Forth in Faith

Learned skills and concepts from previous sessions are reinforced. Assurances of God's constant love is recognized and affirmed. Individualized action plans are formulated and shared.

Four week sessions will begin on June 16th (5:50pm – 8pm) at St. Francis of Assisi, June 18th (8am – 10am) at Blessed Sacrament, August 4th (8am – 10am) at Cathedral, all in Wichita, and on Sept. 3rd (6:30pm – 8:15pm) at St. Cecilia, Haysville.
