BAPTISMS

Parishioners worked many hours pulling wire and installing hardware for this system. They were most kind and very diligent in their work, and the quality shows.

To a number of individuals in the parish who contribute their time and labor to summertime projects and repairs to the church plant. We've had repair work done in our kitchen and in the confessional. Royal Flush Plumbing generously gave of their time and replaced the grease interceptor under the kitchen sink at cost.

We have a new holy water font accessible to the cry room and to the south exit from the church, courtesy of a parishioner. He is also working on a smaller holy water font for the adoration chapel.

Many persons contribute regularly to maintain, to upgrade, and to manage our facility. For each of you, the parish community is most grateful.
