The Word of God in the Digital Age

With the rise of so many digital resources, the Church is fast adapting to using new means of social communication to effect the gospel in the lives of believers and to evangelize a world that does not believe. As a lifelong student, I have always had a special love of media even though my vocation happily led me to a fulfilling participation in the ministerial priesthood. I have long appreciated ongoing formation and education in my field and in related disciplines.

In 2004, I enrolled in a program that studies and works to improve preaching. As a part of that program, I have come to a point where I need to do a project that studies an aspect of preaching. I am designing a project that will focus on the podcast as an instrument in proclaiming the Word of God.

For the most part, the podcast has taken on a life of its own with iPods, iPhones, and other mp3 players. Media theorists have compared the iPod today to the transistor radio of two generations ago. It is mobile and allows the listener to access on demand wherever and whenever desired. Joylon Mitchell, a British expert in new media and religious communications, calls the podcast: the child of the computer and the grandchild of radio.

Podcasts now present the Sunday readings for aural use on the bishops' national website (<http://www.usccb.org/nab/nabpodcast.shtml>). Homilies and sermons are lifted from the weekend worship event and "remediated" (digitized) for access as podcasts (cf., for example, in our own diocese: <http://www.resurrectionwichita.com/multimedia/podcasts>, and http://wchitacathedral.com/index.php?option=com_content&task=blogsection&id=8&Itemid=103). Special preaching is done for podcasts as part of new media ministries (<http://www.wordonfire.org/WOF-Radio/Sermons.aspx>).

I propose to study the use of the podcast as a preparation for the coming Sunday preaching in the homily. Many persons read hypertext (online) or articles in newspapers, magazines, or books to prepare themselves to receive the Word of God proclaimed in the Sunday assembly in the readings and in the preaching. My project will attempt to see how satisfactorily this can be done for a mobile society using an audio format.

I need your help. I need to gauge how persons would participate in our parish. Could you fill out the brief survey below and drop it in the Sunday collection in the next couple weeks? You are not making an obligation at this time. I intend to conduct this project parish-wide, but I will need to insure a certain number of participants so that useful data is collected and I can draw some conclusions from the project.

I am most grateful for your openness and participation. May God richly bless you.
