Baptisms during Easter Season. As in the past, we will be delaying baptisms during the Lenten season until Easter Sunday or Easter season, *except for cases of danger or proximate danger of death, or in cases where it imposes an undue burden on family and extended family who would attend the baptism.* The reason for this practice is to highlight Lent as a preparatory time for baptism and to celebrate the Easter season with baptisms of children and adults coming to the Church for initiation.
