BAPTISMS

God willing, Kyle's first Mass of Thanksgiving as a priest would come just ahead of our parish's *twentieth anniversary!*

Keep our priests, deacons, and seminarians in your prayers. Our diocese has been blessed with a multitude of vocations. Pray also for our married couples and those who are contemplating marriage that God may grant them the grace for their state in life. Finally, pray, too, for religious vocations—for men and women called to religious life as nuns or sisters, brothers, monks, or priests. And pray for all single persons as they discern God's call in their lives.

In Memoriam: This weekend we remember the men and woman who gave their lives for our country so that we might enjoy the freedom to worship and freedom to serve God as Catholic Christians. Please pray for the repose of their souls and consolation for their families.

We keep a special place in the hospitality area of the church where you can write the name of men and women currently serving in our armed forces. It is on a stand by the American flag. We pray for their safety while serving and their return home. This weekend, these names are in the church for your perusal and personal prayer.

At the masses of this weekend, we invite all veterans to stand for a special prayer and blessing. May they and their fallen comrades be brought to eternal life, and their sacrifices never forgotten.

Feast of Corpus Christi—Sunday, June 6, is the Feast of *Corpus Christi*, the Body and Blood of the Lord. This year we are inviting more persons to attend Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament to pray on behalf of and for the Church. Would you be able to give one hour a week in support of this important prayer ministry?

We will also observe the full liturgy of *Corpus Christi* at the 10am mass on June 6. Following the Closing Prayer at Mass, the Blessed Sacrament is incensed and then is carried followed by the congregation in procession, witnessing to our faith in the real presence of Jesus in this august sacrament and offering praise and adoration to God for this great gift. We will process from the church to the parking lot and circle around the furthest parking area immediately west of the Church. The procession will return to the church and all will kneel in the church for benediction (blessing of the people with the Blessed Sacrament).

This liturgy will extend the 10am mass by about 15-20 minutes.

Please do not join the procession or move in front of the Blessed Sacrament to get to your car. One's departure from this procession or rush to beat it would speak ill of our respect and faith in this Sacrament, especially to the public passing by the Church. We are witnessing to them our faith in the Eucharist. Remember, this is the Son of God, the Most Blessed Sacrament, our Savior Whom we adore. Please plan to participate. It may have been years since you took part in the procession. It may be a first time for our young people.

Servers for the 10am mass should plan to be at church at least 20 minutes before mass for instructions. We will use at least two extra servers who may wish to volunteer and also come early that Sunday for 10am mass. Thank you.

Father's Day Card—As we did with Mother's Day, there are signup sheets for Father's Day in the hospitality area of the Church. A holy card of St. Joseph, foster father to the child Jesus, is available on the same table. Please take a card for each father, grandfather, foster father, godfather, etc., as you may need. Put the card in your Father's Day card, and it will tell them they will be remembered in all the masses at Church of the Holy Spirit on Father's Day. There is no gratuity or donation taken with this exercise.

You may also wish to place a card on the grave of a deceased father or beside a memento of a father. On Father's Day, we will also have a special blessing for all our fathers attending mass at Holy Spirit.

Father Nolan's School Project—In January, Father Nolan surveyed the parish for volunteers to help him complete a project for a course of study he has been enrolled in since 2004. The project will entail use of a podcast, accessible online and intended to be a preparation for the Sunday homily. Please feel free to participate. More details will be included in the June 6 bulletin.

A special webpage has been established for this project at: holyspiritwichita.blogspot.com. The page will have a weekly link beginning on June 7th each Monday for a six to eight week period. The link will open a podcast which is intended to help prepare the listener for the following weekend's homily at Church of the Holy Spirit.

This is a qualitative research project intended to see if the podcast as a medium can be used efficaciously in the local church to prepare hearers to receive the Sunday preaching. Your participation and input would be most valuable. Thank you.

A sample podcast using a script of the homily from the Fourth Week of Easter will be uploaded this weekend as a test.

Fun Fact—In the 2008-09 school year, Holy Spirit Catholic School had 70 students in grades K-8. In the just completed 2009-10 school year, Holy Spirit Catholic School had 83 students in grades K-8 and 57 students in 3yo and 4yo Preschool.

The 2010-11 school year is currently enrolling 95 students in grades K-8 and 54 students in 3yo and 4yo Preschool. As future Kindergartens bring enrollments of 18-25 students each year, and new families join the Church of the Holy Spirit, bringing school children of various ages, the school population will require a continued expansion of classes.

With our present trend of upward enrollment, we will have to separate 3rd and 4th grades in the 2011-12 school year and take the present library space for another classroom. The library will have to relocate to shared space in the school.

In the 2013-14 school year, we would have to separate 5th and 6th grades and take the present computer lab for another classroom. In the 2015-16 school year, we would have to separate 7th and 8th grades. This will require still another classroom. In the present configuration of the school, the only available space would be the present school office/teacher's meeting room.

Religious Education classes now fill every classroom, Spirit Hall, and the church office meeting area on Wednesday nights. To accommodate any other activity on Wednesday night is presently difficult at best.

We will have needs for expanded facility space by the fall of 2013. In order to meet this and other needs that will present themselves in the school plan (being readied this summer) and in the parish plan (process to begin this fall), we will first have to retire our present indebtedness.

A growing family needs space to grow. We are blessed to have a growing family and the needs that will coincide with that.
