BAPTISMS

"STEWARDSHIP: THE GRATEFUL RESPONSE OF A CHRISTIAN DISCIPLE"

The readings for today speak to us of God's gift of forgiveness given in response to our sins. In the first reading we hear that David, anointed by God to be king of Israel, fell into sin, was forgiven, but had to suffer punishment for the sin. The reading from Paul's letter to the Galatians clarifies that there is no ritualistic code of conduct that we must follow, but only through faith in the risen Christ will be justified. In the gospel Jesus shows how faith can lead to forgiveness. While in the house of a Pharisee a woman washed Jesus' feet with her tears and Jesus forgave her sins and told her that her faith had saved her. May our faith in Christ be strong enough to accept his forgiveness.

Debt Reduction Campaign

June 2010

Twelve years ago, through the generosity of John and Marilyn Dugan, a gift of land and monies made possible the genesis of the Church of the Holy Spirit in Goddard. A decade ago, 75 families made a pledge to each other and the community to help complete the financing to build the Church of the Holy Spirit by taking out a loan of \$1.3 million. They understand

that they did not have the means to pay off the loan; they just needed to make the minimum payments as the parish would grow and new families would join in the cause. To the Dugan family we owe a debt of gratitude for making this parish possible. To those original families and those who have supported the debt reduction in the past, we give thanks. For all these persons, we thank the Lord for their vision and stewardship.

Today and after three previous campaigns, it is time to renew pledges again to address the \$745,000 remaining as principal on our facilities. From the original 75 families, our parish number has grown to just short of 400 families today. With our numbers it is entirely possible to retire the debt in this campaign.

Each registered family will receive a packet containing information on the pledge drive, a pledge card and instructions. Please fill out the pledge card, either by mailing it, dropping it off at the parish office, or placing it in the collection basket during mass. Those who do not return the pledge cards will be contacted by one of the pledge drive volunteers the weekend of June 26th and 27th to see if there are questions or issues that can be addressed.

If you are new to the parish and have not registered, you, too, can be a part of the drive by picking up a packet at the back of the church and filing it out and returning the card. If you did not receive a packet with your name, please take one of the unnamed packets and return it to the church office.

Like any family, your parish family is growing and soon will have to address some of the needs of our parish facility such as the building of a larger church, expansion of the school for school and religious education classes, or the additions of meeting rooms and a social/reception hall. Later in the year, you will be asked to join in a parish pastoral planning process by way of survey or meeting to help lay the future plans for Church of the Holy Spirit. These are truly exciting times for our parish family.

Today we ask that you discuss with your family and ask the Holy Spirit to provide guidance on your contribution. Thank you for your kind consideration and support.

Weekday Mass schedule for this week only: This week, we will have 8am mass Monday through Friday.

Thank You—To our ushers, servers, and organizers for last Sunday's *Corpus Christi* procession. Everyone's participation was a prayerful sign of our belief in the Real Presence of the Lord in the Blessed Sacrament and of gratitude to God for this gift.

—To our witness talk families at each of the masses of *Corpus Christi* for their testimony to the power of the Eucharistic Lord in their lives.

—To our new volunteers who have signed up to participate in the liturgical apostolate of Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. Their committed hours of prayer "for themselves and for those dear to them and...for the peace and salvation of the world" will be much appreciated. (Quote from *Holy Communion and Worship of the Eucharist Outside Mass*, n. 80)

Cost Conscious and Energy Efficient: Over the summer, groups that normally meet in Spirit Hall are asked to meet in Charity Hall for better energy savings. Charity Hall is much easier to cool and cost efficient. Also, please be sure that when you leave that all lights are off and doors are closed and secured when you leave. Thank You everyone.

Father's Day Card—If you haven't done so yet, be sure to write the father's name down in the hospitality area of the Church and take a holy card of St. Joseph for him. Put the card in your Father's Day card He will be remembered in all the masses at Church of the Holy Spirit on Father's Day. There is no gratuity or donation taken with this exercise.

You may also wish to place a card on the grave of a deceased father or beside a memento of a father. On Father's Day, we will also have a special blessing for all our fathers attending mass at Holy Spirit.
