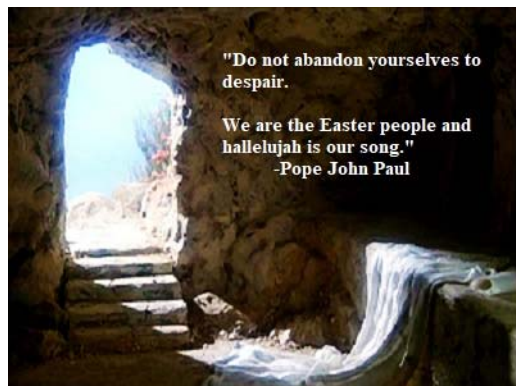

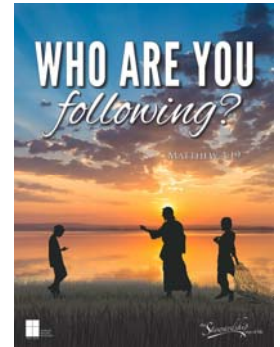

On this most glorious of days, we remember that stewardship is about recognizing and receiving God's gifts and in particular, the gift of faith, as we see in John's gospel today. In the meantime, we are called to live our faith in an authentic way. Consider the words of St. Paul in his letter to the Corinthians: we are the yeast in a fresh batch of dough -- the bread of sincerity and truth. Make a difference today by loving and serving one another, and Christ did for us!



DID YOU KNOW?

- Mass attendance almost doubles on Easter Sunday. This will come as no surprise to the lapsed faithful reading this article, but Easter Sunday is a boon for church attendance. Part of the big three holidays, alongside Thanksgiving and Christmas, Easter see many congregations nearly double their attendance. A Pew Research study of between 2004 and 2013 saw a dramatic spike among Americans for "Church" around Easter and Christmas. As you can see on the updated Google Trends graph below, searches for "Church" still spike twice a year; at Christmas and Easter.
- Unlike other holidays, Easter isn't set on a specific date. Instead, it's set on the first Sunday after the full moon after the vernal equinox, which means that Easter can either fall in the month of March or April.

We recently completed our annual collection for The St. Katharine Drexel Catholic School Fund. This fund supports our lower income schools in the diocese with purchases they would otherwise not be able to make. I wanted to share a story

with you about one of our students and one of our teachers that was shared with me. Stewardship at its finest.

"My old son collected Pokémon cards like a crazy person. Any scrap of money that he earned meant more cards. He asked for clear holders for Christmas so he could display them. He researched them and carefully traded them. So you can imagine my surprise when he asked if he could sell them all a couple of months ago. I asked why.

He wanted to give the money to the Drexel fund, a school-supported charity for the poor schools in our diocese. My mama heart cried out. I knew how it hurt him to sell them. But how could I discourage that?

So I posted his cards on our school Facebook page. A kind teacher bought them. David donated all of the money. Yesterday David brought home a gift. It was from that teacher. She gave him back his Pokémon cards."

I am so proud of this student, and I am so proud of our teacher. God is good all the time. All the time, God is good.
